**Previata Pinot Grigio Friuli Grave (Italy)** 8.20 5.75 4.10 22.00

Crisp and fruity with crunchy fruit, citrusy acidity and a long, refreshing finish

**San Andres Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)** 8.20 5.75 4.10 22.00

An aromatic lively wine with fresh flavours of lime and gooseberry and a zesty citrus aroma. A good match with fish in batter, salads and spicy chicken

**3. Highveld Chenin Sauvignon Blanc 2021 (South Africa)** 23.50

Light bodied, juicy yet subtle unwooded Chenin which has distinctive fresh fruit aromatics and tastes.

**1. Sauvignon Blanc – Alba, Santa Luz 2022/3 (Chile)** 23.90

A zingy sauvignon with signature lime and fresh cut grass aromas. A crisp clean finish rounds the wine off beautifully.

**4. Chardonnay – Alba, Santa Luz 2022 (Chile)** 23.90

An unoaked Chardonnay showing the best qualities of the grape: luscious tropical fruit of melon and guava and a rounded texture.

**38. Chardonnay Santa Helena Varietal (Chile)** 26.00

A very popular wine, crisp and fresh white packed full of zingy citrus flavour.

**5. Piquepoul, Henri de Richemer 2022 (France)** 28.50

A very popular wine, crisp and fresh white packed full of zingy citrus flavour.

**6. Viognier Château Routas 2021/2 (France)** 30.70

Juicy pineapple and peach notes abound in this clean and refreshing wine with an aromatic, bright finish.

**40. Sauvignon Blanc – Marquis de Goulaine 2022 (France)** 33.50

Flinty zesty Sauvignon from France's cool Loire Valley. All the sophistication of a Sancerre.

**7. Sauvignon Blanc – Pa Road 2022 (New Zealand)** 40.50

Aromatic with lovely citrus fruit, gooseberry and green apple with ripe melon, mixed with subtle herbaceous mineral notes. Rich in flavour and long in the mouth.

**8. White Zinfandel Rosé - Compass Point 2021 (USA)** 27.00

Californian Rosé full to bursting with flavours of ripe strawberry and juicy watermelon combined with a delicate sweetness on the palate.

**9. Rosé – Alba, Santa Luz 2022 (Chile)** 23.90

A wonderful intense flavour of sweet cherry, raspberry and hints of strawberry, a more dry rose.

**San Andres Merlot (Chile)**

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Elegant and well structured with aromas of chocolate, cherry and mocha. Soft generous fruit flavours of ripe cherry and plum and a delicate hint of spice

**Palazzo Nero d’Avola (Italy)**

9.90	6.95	4.95	26.55
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With a bright, deep red colour, this wine has intense red-fruit and plum aromas with touches of toast, vanilla and spice and goes perfectly with grilled red meats, charcuterie and cheese

**35. McGuigan Zero Shiraz (Australia) – alcohol free** 12.25

**11. Malbec Loma Negra 2022/3 (Chile)** 24.50

A bright juicy Malbec, showing hints of violets and tobacco. The palate is well structured, with soft tannins and oodles of fruit on the finish.

**29. Côtes du Rhône Cellier d’Or (France)** 24.50

A medium-bodied rich, dark red wine with appealing aromas of peppery spice and soft warm berries. Ideal with red meats, game and cheese.

**12. Shiraz Crooked Mick 2020/1 (Australia)** 27.00

Sunshine in a bottle. Jammy fruits of strawberry and blackcurrant with a touch of spice.

- 13. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Dea del Mare 2020/1 (Italy)** 27.00  
Wonderful aromas of violet and red fruits, with a touch of savoury on the finish.
- 14. Rioja Joven Valdepalacios 2022 (Spain)** 29.00  
A seductive nose of plum and currants lead into a plump mouthful with spice and cranberry flavours
- 42. Côtes du Rhône Calvet 2023 (France)** 29.50  
A warm nose of red fruits like strawberries, blackberries, currants and spices
- 24. Shiraz Cabernet Foxgrove (Australia)** 29.75  
A seductive nose of plum and currants lead into a plump mouthful with spice and cranberry flavours
- 43. Hardys Cabernet Sauvignon (Australia)** 30.00  
Lots of oak and sweet cherry, figs, dates and plum on the nose. Red apples and spices on the midpalate. Medium to light tannins with a round finish
- 41. Nero di Troia – Antica Masseria Colleone 2021 (Italy)** 31.00  
A less well-known grape from the south, but well worth discovering. A charming nose of ripe red fruits, cherries and stoney earth. On the palate there are ripe fruits together with hints of spices and tobacco before a finish with flint and earthy notes.
- 22. Rioja Tempranillo Marquès de Mejia 2020 (Spain)** 31.50  
An easy-drinking Rioja made from grapes grown in the Rioja Baja area, and aged for just three months in barrel to add an attractive spicy note to the wine's fresh, fruity flavour.
- 16. Cabernet Sauvignon Marcel Martin 2021 (France)** 29.50  
A classic style French Cabernet; good structure and length with blackcurrant and cedar aromas, perfect with rich red meat dishes.
- 25. Cockburns of Leith Vintage Claret (France)** 35.00  
A classically styled claret with blackcurrant fruit, fine, firm tannins and hints of vanilla and spice. From Scotland's oldest wine merchants who have always bottled claret, insisting the wine is always well balanced with a good length.
- 39. Primitivo 'Passitivo' (Appassimento) Paulo Leo (Italy)** 36.25  
This wine borrows the famous technique from Amarone of drying the grapes prior to fermentation. This gives a full bodied, rich, and powerful wine. The nose is complex

with cherries, raspberries, and chocolate. The palate is dominated by dried fruit flavours and spice, although powerful it is skilfully kept well balanced.

**26. Malbec Familia Barberis, Bodega Barberis (Argentina)** 37.00  
A seductive nose of plum and currants lead into a plump mouthful with spice and cranberry flavours.

**27. Pinot Noir PA Road (New Zealand)** 47.50  
A classy wine with great concentration. Dark fruits of black cherry and cassis leading to a savoury palate with spicy notes.

**28. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Heritage, Calvet 2021 (France)** 64.00  
Intense ruby red with purple reflections. The bouquet is rich and complex flavours of bitter cherry, cinnamon and “Earthy”. Full bodied, well balanced with a long persistence with round tannins. It is an elegant wine with a spicy finish. Typical Châteauneuf-du-Pape with deep flavour and colour with a lasting after-taste.

**37. Barolo Sant Orsola 2018 (Italy)** 68.00  
Garnet red in colour with orange nuances. The perfume is typical, ethereal, pleasant, intense with notes of violet and rose. Suitable for roast meats, game and meat dishes.
